Bids received after this time will be rejected.

Checks shall be payable to 'Town of North Branford'. All bids must be obtained at this location.

All work under this contract shall be done in conformance with the State of Connecticut Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications for Roads, Bridges, and Incidental Construction, Form 816, 2004 including Supplemental Specifications, dated January 2010, unless otherwise noted.

A certified check or bid bond for the sum of ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid, payable to the Town of North Branford, must accompany the bid, as a guarantee that the contract will be entered into, if awarded. The bid bond surety must be a corporate surety company licensed to sign surety bonds in the State of Connecticut.

The right is reserved to reject any and or all bids, in whole or in part, to award any item, group of items, or total bid, and to waive informality or technical defects, if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of North Branford.

Minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids and are encouraged to do so. The Town of North Branford is an Affirmative Action E.O.E.
