Chief Canelli stated that he is concerned with the deer across from Big Y and is wondering if the Commission has any ideas on how to protect the public. After much discussion it was decided that they would try and put a squad car with the lights on at dawn and dusk to at least try and slow down the traffic until this snow thaws.
