Chief Canelli advised the Commission that there was a Police Car accident involving Officer Manor. The insurance will pay \$17,000 along with the supplies/special equipment for the vehicle and we have that figured to be about \$9,000.

Chief Canelli had Lt. D'Ancicco give a report on the K-9. Lt. D'Ancicco stated that due to the inclement weather, it has pushed the start date back with the State. They are thinking April, May and June Training. All of the equipment has been purchased; we are just waiting for a green light from the State.

7. TRAFFIC AUTHORITY

- a. Matt's Mission Fund, Road Closures Mill, Totoket and Caputo Road

Lt. D'Ancicco reviewed the run with the Commission stating that it will be the same exact run as last year.

- b. Mill Road – Request for Stop Signs

Deputy Chief Doody reviewed Lt. D'Ancicco's Traffic Survey stating that stop signs are not needed and to issue adequate notice to the patrol division when the field becomes active and enforce the existing speed limit by means of radar and lidar.

- c. Dinwoodie Drive, Request for Sight Impaired Child

Deputy Chief Doody reviewed Lt. D'Ancicco's Traffic Survey stating that he recommends installing four 25 MPH speed limit signs along with four motorist warning signs denoting sight impaired children in area. .

Commissioner Landolfi moved, seconded by Commissioner Pollock to approve Lt. D'Ancicco's recommendations. The motion was carried unanimously.
