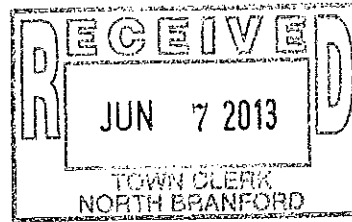

Volunteers for June 1, 2013 Recyclables Collection – Liz Boissard and Michael Martin volunteered to work


Report from SWAC meeting – Tom Scelfo Regarding the mattress ordinance waiting to hear.
