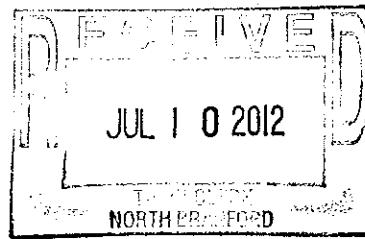

Agenda Discussion Notes HAZARDOUS WASTE/RECYCLING COMMITTEE Thursday, June 14, 2012 Town Hall - 7:30 p.m.

Members Present: Mary Bigelow, Thomas Scelfo, David Bowen, Donna Cordone, Art Feldman and Abigaile Rose??

Members Absent: Elizabeth Boissard, Hank Petrowsky, Nancy Ciancuilli, and Deborah Anderson

As there were not enough members present for a quorum, the following is a summary of the items discussed:

Mary reported that Michelle Knockwood was at meeting with the Superintendent of Schools, Scott Schoonmaker and he made a statement that the schools did not know what to do with recycling. At that time Michelle stood up and stated that the Hazardous Waste/Recycling Committee has approached all of the schools on numerous occasions with regard to their recycling and also brought up all of the things the Committee has done to improve recycling efforts.

Mary briefly reviewed WeRecycle report of collections.

Hank was not present, but did report to Mary that all Hazwaste signs were up and that there is one that is cracked. Art added that one was run into by a car and is not usable. Hank also reported that he forwarded school recycling notice to all of the appropriate teachers in each school. Hank also stated that he spoke with Deb Ferraro again about joining the group and she thinks she is available to join now. He also stated that he will be working at the Ewaste collection on the 7th. Donna stated that she is pushing the advertising for the collection on July 7th. Art stated that he can be a backup if knee his is better and Dave stated that he will also attempt to be there.

Art is concentrating on getting quotes in for the signs, stating that he is making a modification and replacing two existing signs. One modification is the identification of hours and the second is a summary of what is acceptable for various types of collections. He also stated that he needs Gina to work on the FAQs and get information on the Town website. Art suggested checking out the local channel and noted that he has corrections to be made to the recycling portion of the website.
