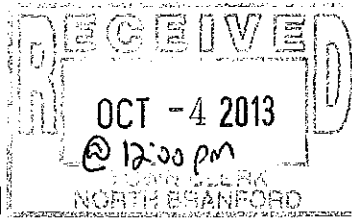

#### 8. Miscellaneous:


