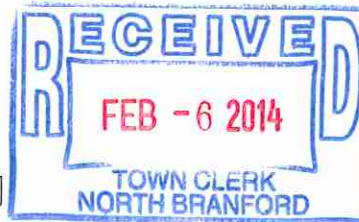


**7. Other Business:**
