

Aerosol containers, empty	Place in blue recycling barrel
Aerosol containers, not empty	Bring to HazWaste Central
Antifreeze	HazWaste Central
Aseptic boxes	Place in blue recycling barrel (aseptics are boxes that look/feel like cardboard coated with a waxy coating – most common are juice boxes, broth, soup, tomato sauce).
Audio and Video Tapes	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
AV cables and cord	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Bathroom cleaning products	HazWaste Central
Batteries, rechargeable	Bring to our Electronics Recycling collection
Batteries, regular	HazWaste Central
Blu-Ray players	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Brake Fluid	HazWaste Central
Bug Sprays	HazWaste Central
Bulky Waste – ACCEPTABLE ITEMS	Can be placed at the curbside for pickup on your regular trash day. Tree limbs, tree branches, scrap wood, & rugs: all of these need to be less than 4 feet long, no thicker than 4 inches, and must be bundled and tied. Other acceptable items: couches, mattresses, box springs, picnic tables, wooden furniture. However, see exception about cleaning out an entire household below. If you are not sure about an item, call John's Refuse 484-0281.
Bulky Waste NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS	These CANNOT be put out for regular trash pickup: Tires, construction waste, grass clippings, land clearing/demolition debris; propane or helium tanks, electronics, riding mowers, scrap vehicles or parts, cans or drums larger than 5 gallons.

Cell Phones	May be dropped off at Public Works Office during their normal office hours; brought to North Branford's Electronics Recycling Collection Day; or donated to one of the many groups that collects them for reuse (Google "donate cell phones" to see the many ways you can do this).
Chairs	See Bulky Waste above.
Christmas Cards, wrapping paper	Place in your blue recycling barrel
Christmas Tree Pickup	Are picked up as part of your regular trash, on your scheduled pickup day. See your Recycling Card for specific dates this year – generally, the first or second week in January.

Cleaning products	HazWaste Central
Computer mouse	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Construction waste	Have contractor remove waste from your project; call trash hauler such as John's Refuse for a dumpster
Cooking oil	HazWaste Central
Couches	See Bulky Waste above.
Copy machine	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Data cartridges	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection

Disinfectants	HazWaste Central
Drain openers	HazWaste Central
Dry-cleaning solvents	HazWaste Central
Electronics	TV's, computers & monitors, printers, tape recorders, DVD players, microwave ovens, space heaters, irons, etc. Basically, if it has an electrical cord it's probably acceptable – bring to North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collections.
Envelopes (including those with transparent windows)	Place in your blue recycling barrel

Extension Cords (electrical)	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
External CD-ROM drives	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection

Fertilizers	HazWaste Central
Fire Extinguishers	Currently, there is no state-organized or free way to dispose of fire extinguishers – you must use a private company to dispose of them properly. A good local source is New Haven County Fire Extinguisher Service in East Haven; contact them at 203 469 1990. They charge approximately \$10 to recycle them properly. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO DISCHARGE THEM ON YOUR OWN; bring them “as is” to the company.

Fluorescent light bulbs	HazWaste Central
Fungicides	HazWaste Central
Furniture polish	HazWaste Central
Gasoline	HazWaste Central
Glass (e.g., broken window glass, drinking glasses, Pyrex, milk- or other-colored glass)	Place in brown Trash barrel
Grass clippings	Compost on your property; bring to the town Leaf Collection in the Spring and/or Fall.
Hard disk drives	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Helium Tanks	Can be brought to any one of our four Quarterly Recycling Events at the town Recycling Center (Public Works). There is a size-based fee for Helium tanks (currently \$5 for small tanks). Do not leave tanks unattended at Public Works – creates a potentially hazardous situation
Herbicides (weed / brush killers)	HazWaste Central
Household cleanout	If you are cleaning out a home because of a move, death, nursing home placement, etc., please contact one of the many organizations that will pick up furniture, clothing, housewares, small appliances, etc., such as Big Brothers Big Sisters (toll free: 1-877-399-2570); the Salvation Army or Goodwill Industries . Some donations may even qualify as tax deductible.
Insecticides	HazWaste Central
Junk mail	Place in your blue recycling barrel

Kerosene	HazWaste Central
Keyboards (computer)	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Leaf Dropoff Area	In both the Fall and Spring, North Branford allows residents to bring leaves to our drop-off area, located at the rear of the public works / police station on Route 22. Volunteers will be available to direct you re how and where to dump your grass clippings, leaves, and small twigs. NO limbs, branches, tree stumps, etc.
Leaf Pickup (Curbside)	Leaves must be placed in biodegradable paper bags. Leave bags open at the top – do not tape them shut. Place at the curbside on your normally scheduled pickup day during the collection period – there is one in the Spring, and one in the Fall. Specific dates are on this year's Recycling Card.
Light bulbs (incandescent)	Place in regular trash

Milk cartons	Place in blue recycling barrel

Motor Oil (NOT mixed w/ anything else)	Can be dropped off at Public Works on Route 22; or bring to HazWaste Central;
Motor Oil mixed w/ gasoline, antifreeze, or any other substance	HazWaste Central
MP3 players	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Orange juice carton	Place in blue recycling barrel
Oven cleaners	HazWaste Central
Overhead projectors	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Paint (oil or latex based)	Bring to paint drop-off location. To find the one nearest you, go to www.paintcare.org and put in your zip code.
Paint strippers	HazWaste Central
Paint thinners	HazWaste Central
Photography chemicals	HazWaste Central

Pool chemicals	HazWaste Central
Power supplies	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Propane Tanks	Can be brought to any one of our Recycling Events at the town Recycling Center (Public Works). There is a size-based fee for propane tanks: currently, \$1 for tanks up to 100 lbs; \$10 for larger. Do not leave tanks unattended at Public Works – creates a potentially hazardous situation.
Rugs	Must be rolled and tied; see Bulky Waste above.
Scanners	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Scrap Metal	Consists of things like air conditioners, metal lawn furniture, large appliances (refrigerators: remove doors for safety), tools, hot water tanks, metal fencing, filing cabinets, furnaces, garbage pails, outdoor

	grills, non-riding lawn mowers (remove gas!!), aluminum siding, small machines.
Scrap wood (small amounts/pieces)	Small amounts only – no pieces longer than 4 feet. Place out for pickup on your normal collection day.
Shredded paper	Place in a clear (transparent) plastic bag; tie; place in your blue recycling barrel
Slide projectors	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Stereo speakers	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Stereos	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Styrofoam	Place in regular trash
Tape drives	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Telephones (corded or hand-held)	North Branford's Electronic Recycling Collection
Telephone books	Place in your blue recycling barrel
Tires	Tires cannot be placed in weekly Trash or Recycling, not left for Curbside Pickup. Bring tires to our Quarterly Recycling event in the Fall – usually held in October. This is the only time of the year when we can take tires. There is a size-based fee for tires: currently \$5 for up to 20", \$10 for over 20", \$25 for very large tires [farm tractor, etc].
Transmission fluid	HazWaste Central
Trash Pickup Holidays	New Year's Day; Memorial Day; Fourth of July; Labor Day; Thanksgiving; Christmas. Pickup will be delayed one day following trash holidays.
Tree limbs & branches	Cut into pieces no longer than 4 feet; tie together; place out for pickup on your normal collection day.
